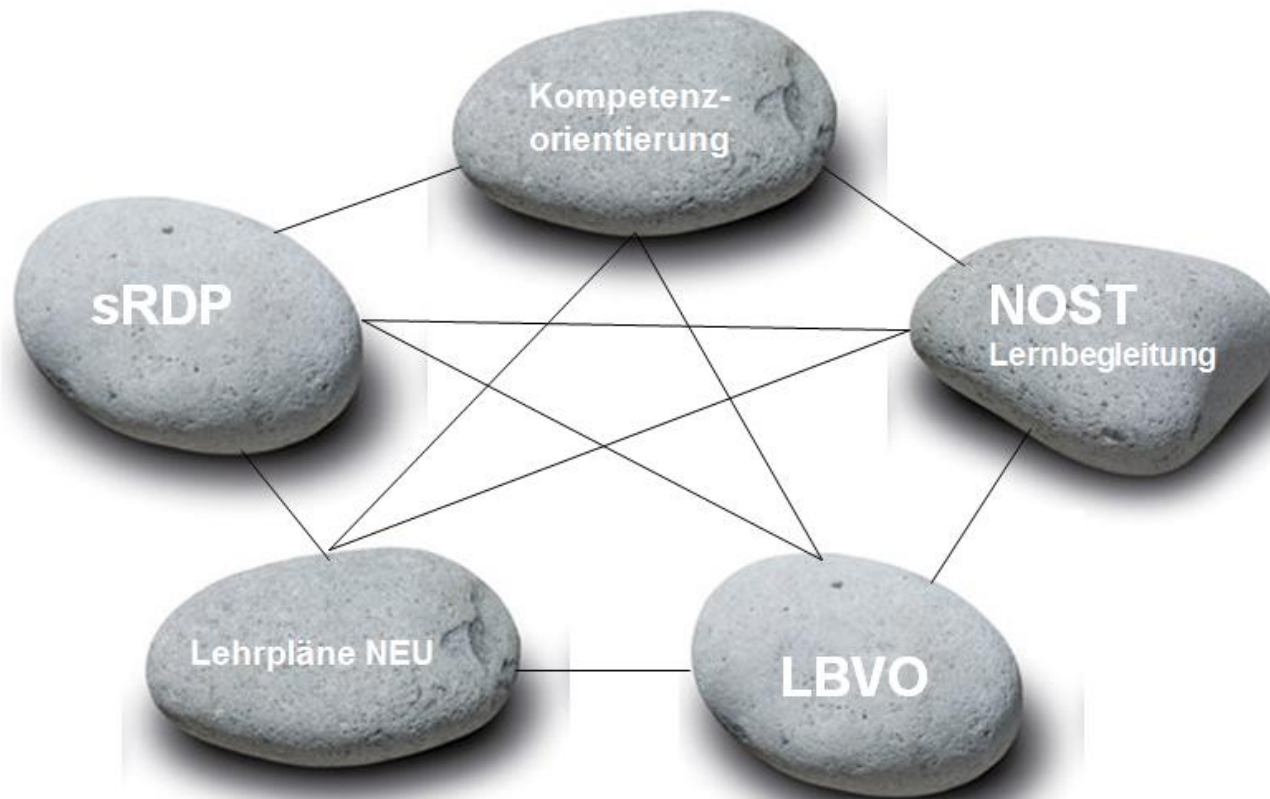

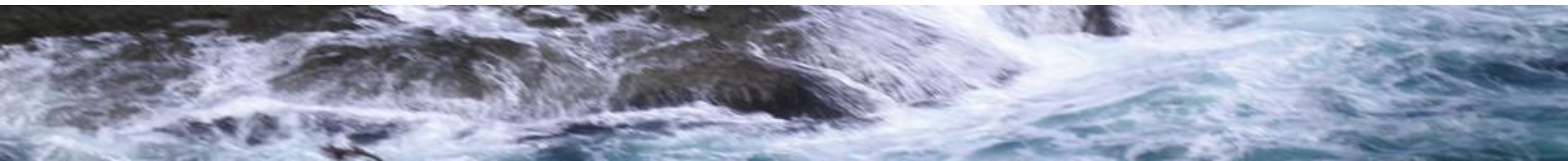

Structure / Implementation in everyday teaching and learning

- *A thorough planning of CLIL lessons supports teachers and learners and will lead to feeling safe in the classroom (→ K. Kelly: "mechanics" of lessons)*
- *Use material available!*

Mind didactics in order to prevent your students being passive spectators!

- *Make your students active!*

CLIL is definitely NOT a teacher's language training!

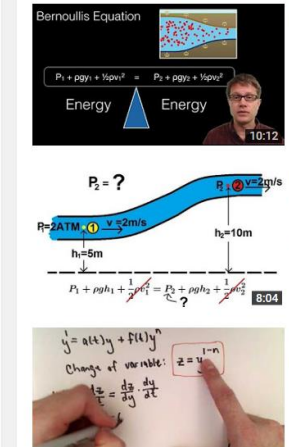

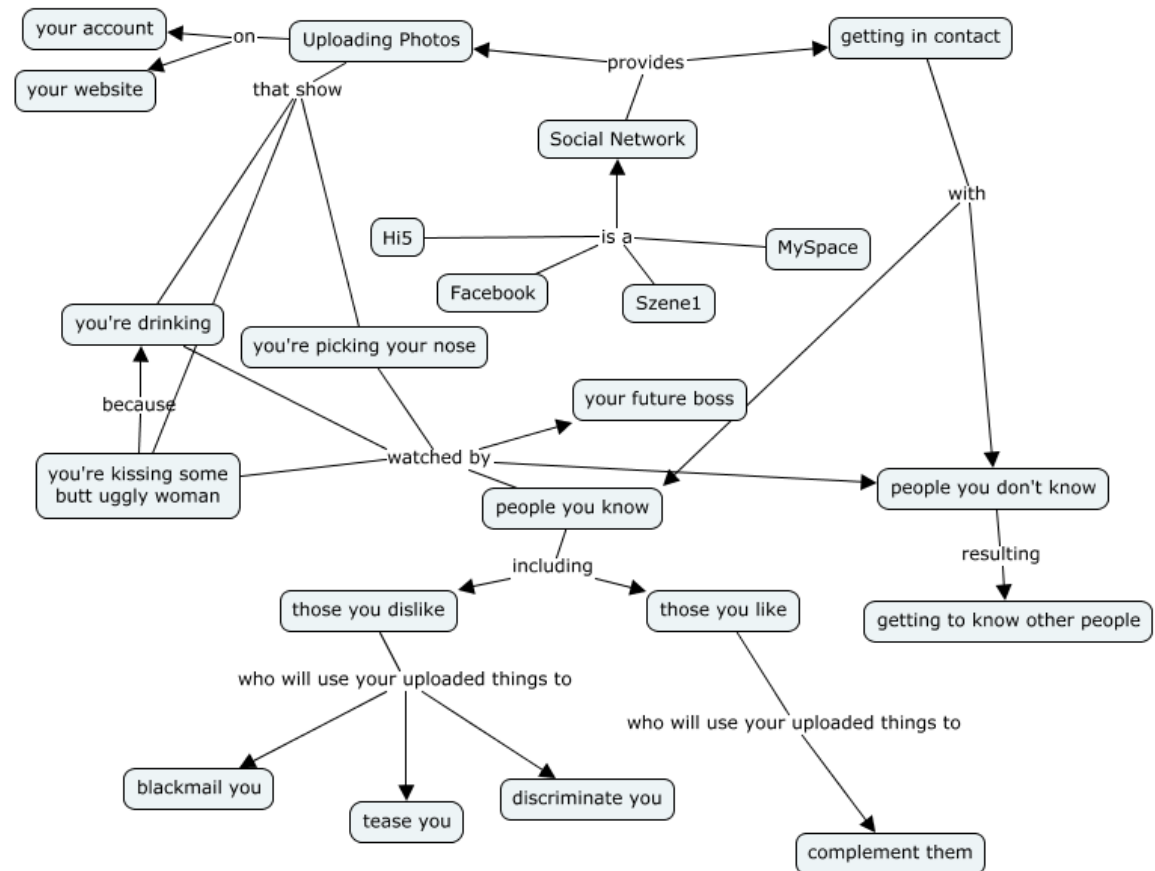

Intercultural approach / Communication – "key assumptions"

- Consider your students' future labour situation in international project teams
- Language is mainly used for communication (and not for filling in the correct words in exercises).
- Linguistic correctness and native English doesn't always lead to ensured communication and understanding in multilingual teams. (→ K. Kelly: ... help your students to deal with misunderstanding...)
- Flexibility and paraphrasing are essential competences in a multilingual communication process. CLIL is a perfect training camp in this respect!

Linguistic background / Grammar correctness – communicative competence

- **CLIL lesson ≠ English lesson**
As their objectives are different you can't apply the same rules or standards!
- The focus on grammar correctness can be an obstacle **to** an automatic switch to a foreign language
- Nevertheless
 - ... try to avoid "Germanisms"
 - ... concentrate on the correct English word order
 - ... focus on the correct prepositions as they are essential in explaining and describing a technical context
 - ... train linkers and adverbial phrases
 -

Success factors

- Be yourself!
- Let your students talk – it's *their* CLIL-lesson (→ K. Kelly: create communicative opportunities)
- Train the "automatic switch"
- Start thinking in English and do not translate
- Share materials and experience with colleagues
- Have fun ...
