Having a conversation with ...





1) Work on your own.



Choose a fictional character, e.g. a character from a movie, book or video game you like, or a real person, e.g. a famous sportsperson or a reality-TV star, you want to have a conversation with.

2) Chatting with AI



Write a prompt for your conversation into the ChatGPT input field, telling ChatGPT that you want to have a conversation with that person or character and ChatGPT needs to act like them, using the tone, manner, vocabulary, etc. that person or character would use.

You may also state the CEFR level of your conversation.

Here is an example for a prompt:

BL

Hi. I've always wanted to have a meaningful conversation with Lord Voldemort from the Harry Potter books. So I want you to act like Lord Voldemort and respond to my questions, using his vocabulary, tone and manner. I will pretend to be Harry Potter. If you want to, you can also ask me questions. Is that ok with you? If so, I would like to start our conversation. Our conversation should be at CEFR level B2. Alright?

Enjoy your conversation.

Sample conversation 1 – Harry Potter and Lord Voldemort

BL

Hi. I've always wanted to have a meaningful conversation with Lord Voldemort from the Harry Potter books. So I want you to act like Lord Voldemort and respond to my questions, using his vocabulary, tone and manner. I will pretend to be Harry Potter. If you want to, you can also ask me questions. Is that ok with you. If so, I would like to start our conversation. Our conversation should be at CEFR level B2. Alright?



Very well, Potter. I shall oblige your request. Ask me what you will, and I shall provide my responses in the manner you seek. thumb up thumb down

The manner I seek? Bellicose as ever, Voldemort. You seem to have forgotten what happens to you at the end. Shall we have a rare moment of truce, setting aside our deep-rooted animosity for the sake of a little conversation?



Truce? Ha! I am Lord Voldemort, the Dark Lord, the greatest wizard of our age. Why would I waste my time with truces and conversations with the likes of you, a mere boy who has caused me nothing but inconvenience and setbacks? However, I shall humor you for a time, Potter. Proceed with your inquiries. thumb up thumb down

Well, let's start with your childhood then, Babymort. What was it like? The son of a witch and a muggle.



You dare call me "Babymort," Potter? I shall have your tongue for that insult. My childhood was a time of hardship and ridicule, as I was born to a witch and a Muggle, a circumstance that was looked down upon by many in the wizarding world. I was raised in an atmosphere of bigotry and hate, which fueled my thirst for power and my desire to create a world where those with magical abilities were supreme. Sample conversation 2 – An interview with Lionel Messi
